

Parent and Camper information

What to bring:

Tennis Shoes for recreation
Extra shoes
Bath towels and wash cloth
Toiletry articles (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
Plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes
Flash Light
Medicines (must take to nurse)
Bible
Notebook and pen
Spending money
Sleeping bag or bedding
Pillow
Pajamas
Socks & under clothes
Recreational clothes
Jeans, Modest shorts & shirts
Sweat shirt or jacket
Modest one-piece swimsuit
Beach Towel
Raincoat (optional)

Do Not Bring: No radios, I-pods, MP3 players or video games or equipment, fireworks, firearms, tobacco or e-cigarettes/vapes, weapons, alcohol, drugs, pets, inappropriate clothing (see dress policy), no color hair spray, no permanent ink markers. All cell phones must be turned in.

Dress Policy: Clothing must be modest. Swimsuits must be modest one-piece suits. Please be sure campers note this so they pack appropriately. Your dress reflects the quality of the camp. All campers are expected to dress and groom themselves neatly and modestly. Inappropriate clothes (such as those with alcohol, tobacco, satanic or sexual slogans, or immodest) are not permitted. No Bikinis and no two-piece swim suits. Pack clothing according to this policy. Thank you!

Visits and Call: It is recommended that parents refrain from visiting with, or calling their children during camp. Camp office phone number during youth camps (715 374 2130) only campers and staff registered for the current week of camp are allowed on grounds. Evening services and camp programs are not open to the public. For necessary visits, please check in with the camp office.

Medications: All medications brought to camp MUST have original Pharmacy label & clearly labeled to include: 1) camper's name, 2) name of prescribing physician, 3) prescription number, 4) date prescribed, 5) name of medication, 6) directions for use. All medications are to be kept by the camp nurse. It is the responsibility of the camper to go to the Nurse Office for

medications at prescribed times. Parent must send any updated health/medication or particular care information in writing with the camper.

Fee Payment: The final balance is due upon arrival at camp. Please be sure you have prepared the correct payment as shown on your Pre-Registration Report. Make the check out to your church. Thank you! If balance is not paid then camper will not be accepted.

Lost & Found: Please mark your camper's belongings. It is the camper's responsibility to check the Lost & Found in the office for lost items. A fee will be charged if you request us to ship lost and found articles. Lost and found items are kept only until approximately August 31, then donated to charity.
